Poster Making for COVID Awareness- 12th November, 2021

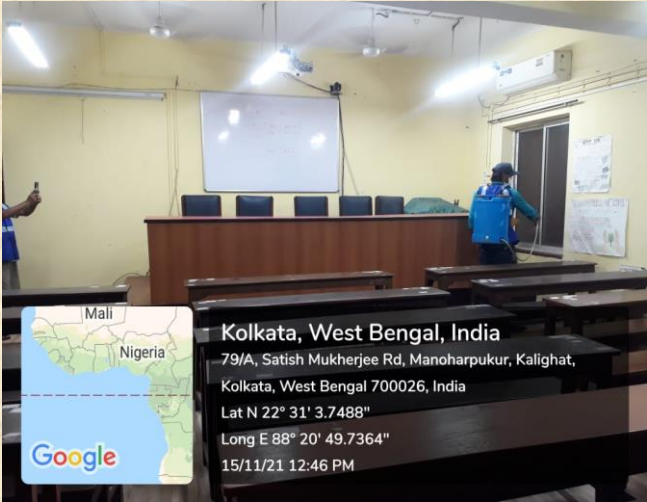

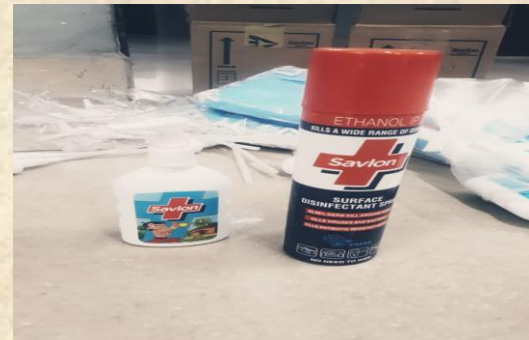
Sanitisation by Kolkata Corporation- 15th November, 2021
